






Project Overview

The Streetcar East (SCE) Extension project is the first expansion of the existing downtown Streetcar. This transit project meets MARTA and City of Atlanta goals of providing greater access to popular destinations like the Georgia World Congress Center, Centennial Olympic Park, Downtown Atlanta, the MLK National Park, the Edgewood Commercial District, as well as Old Fourth Ward and the Poncey Highland neighborhoods along the Atlanta BeltLine corridor. The project begins at the intersection of Jackson Avenue and Edgewood Avenue and ends just south of Ponce de Leon Avenue.





STREETCAR EAST EXTENSION PROJECT Proposed Alignment and Stop Locations






STREETCAR EAST EXTENSION PROJECT Proposed Plan Views



BeltLine Roll Plot




In-Street Roll Plot






Typical Cross Section Locations



Typical Cross Section Options







There are two alternatives for space allocation being considered along Edgewood Avenue: a cycle track along Edgewood Avenue (option 2) and the extended Auburn/Edgewood Bike Couplet (option 3). Both options assume two-way streetcar service along Edgewood Avenue.
